In Suriname, the main institutions involved for water management are the Ministry of Natural Resources, the Ministry of Agriculture, Animal husbandry and Fisheries, the Ministry of Public Works, Transport and Tourism and the Ministry of Public Health.

The Ministry of Natural Resources controls the exploitation and management of all natural resources, including water and energy. Under the authority of the ministry, the Suriname Water Supply Company (SWM) is responsible for the water supply in the coastal area and the hinterland.

The Ministry of Public Works, Transports and Communication is responsible for monitoring of Water resources in quality and quantity, through its Hydraulic Research Division (WLA). It is also in charge of producing knowledge on climate and precipitation, through The Meteorological Service (MDS).


The Ministry of Agriculture is responsible of water management for the agriculture sector and aquaculture. It also monitors and regulate the fishing sector.

The Ministry of Health is in charge of all health/water quality related issues.

Other governmental institutions involved in water affairs of Suriname are the Ministry of Planning, Land and Forest Management, the Ministry of Regional Development and the National Institute for Environment and Development (NIMOS).

To date, no national water authority or water resources council, and national water law, has been established. Legislation regarding the ground water protection areas has been drafted and is expecting to be approved.

Local government is defined by the 1987 constitution in Suriname, with two levels: the *distrikten* (districts), and the *ressorten* (sub-district). They do not have direct legal competencies for water management yet.
